Our Facility

The Dance Shoppe is a bright and family friendly dance studio. We have five large state of the art dance rooms, all with viewing windows and a closed-circuit video system so you may watch all your dancers on one screen or remotely on your phone or tablet. Our 12,000 square foot dance complex has a front and back entrance to make it convenient to park and enter during busy times and inclement weather. Our spacious hallways and kitchenette make for a comfortable family atmosphere and allow you to enjoy your time at The Dance Shoppe. Each dance studio is individually controlled for heat and air conditioning to allow for an optimum temperature for your dancer to train in. The generous girls and boys change rooms/washrooms are both equipped with baby change stations along with lockers and hot and cold running water. The professional décor is both relaxing and tranquil. We are located in an area close to shopping and restaurants, with easy excess to the highway. We encourage you to come in and watch each class so you can see the enjoyment and the development of your dancer.

Recreational Program

The Dance Shoppe offers classes from pre-school up to adult. Our programs enhance rhythm skills, coordination, musicality, self-esteem, and the love of dance! Classes are offered during weeknights and Saturdays for your convenience. Pre-school dancers, @age 2 years are enrolled into our Kinder Dance program. Dancers 3 years and up can enroll in any of the many forms of dance we offer. Classes vary from 30 minutes a class to 1-hour classes. Students enrolled in our regular dance program have the option to perform at The Dance Shoppe's year end recital.

Part Time and Full Time Competitive Program

Our competitive program is designed for dancers who wish to pursue an advanced level of training. The program is divided into teams. The dancers are placed on a team according to technique, skill level, and age. Competitive dancers represent the studio at different competitions though out the year, as well as at many community events and all Dance Shoppe functions. Competitive dancers strive to achieve their goals, build confidence, and conduct themselves in a sportsman like manner at all times. Contact the studio today to book your competitive assessment.

Year End Recital

The Dance Shoppe is proud to present our year end Dance Recital on the third weekend in June. This is a production put together of all the dance programs offered at the studio. The dancers perform on stage, showcasing their hard work and fun in a professional environment, with professional staging, lights and sound. We invite family, friends and the general public to attend this wonderful event. The recital is optional for our dancers, but it is an up-lifting experience that will provide them with memories for a lifetime. Each student is fitted for a costume, ordered especially for your dancer.

Dance Examinations

Many of The Dance Shoppe dancers are offered to take their exams in one or more disciplines. Examinations give your dancer the opportunity to present what they have achieved and be awarded a mark and certificate. Exam students must attend the minimum class requirements in order to be considered for exam classes.

Each exam carries an additional class and fees.

Newsletters and Updates

Newsletters are emailed monthly and as required. It is your responsibility to read these. There are always extra copies of the newsletter at the front desk, posted on the bulletin board, and on our website.

Tuition: Classes run from the second week of September to @ the 3rd weekend in June.

Payment Plan: 10 Payments/ Installments - Visa / MasterCard

Pre-Authorized payment. Tuition Fee to be paid in ten (10) equal payments/installments. You must provide either Visa or MC. **The 1st payment is due at registration.** Monthly payments will be automatically deducted from your account, on the 1st of each subsequent month starting October 1st, 2024, through June 1st2025. Any outstanding balances will be automatically deducted from your account on July 1, 2025.

Cancellation policy:

Cancelling within 30 days of registration or within your first 30 days of classes:

Within 30 days after your registration date and or first 30 days of classes, a refund of the tuition balance only will be made, or future payments will be suspended. Your cancellation request must be received in writing (email) within 30 days of your first class. dance@thedanceshoppe.com

Cancelling after your first 30 days of classes:

If you would like to cancel your membership, you are required to advise us via email 30 days prior to cancellation so that we can process and cancel your pre-authorized payments. Please email us at dance@thedanceshoppe.com. If you have pre-paid for the year, you will receive a credit only on your account to be used later or for another program.

Cancelling by TDS:

The Dance Shoppe reserves the right to cancel, withdraw or suspend any dancer or dancers at any time for reasons deemed fit by them and their agents. Should the need arise for the studio to cancel, withdraw or suspend a dancer; a refund of the tuition balance only will be made and or the monthly installments discontinued.

Should The Dance Shoppe be forced to close due to municipal/provincial/federal guidelines at a later date, the following will be applied: A) TDS will firstly attempt to make up any missed classes. All tuition fees will still be applied in this case. B) Should TDS not be able to makeup missed classes a credit may be applied to the dancers account to reflect the amount of tuition for the classes missed. Monthly payments for tuition will be suspended. C) All other fees are non-refundable and will be evaluated case by case for the possibility of a credit. This includes but is not limited to costume deposits, birthday party deposits, competitive entry fees etc. These credits are largely dependent on our suppliers.

Dance Programs Offered

Parent & Tot: Age @2 years – An introductory class which encourages dancers to explore different types of movement through guidance from the teacher. The focus is fun while learning to be in a classroom setting and exploring creative dance through music and movement.

Kinder Gym: Age 3/4yrs - A creative movement and acro dance based program where dancers can explore their creativity while combining gymnastics and jazz dance. Dancers will practice controlled movements, build strength and stability through conditioning, and basic Acro skills.

Kinder Bop: Age 3/4yrs A high energy class which combines Jazz and Hip Hop choreographed to music using styles like hip hop, and free style. A creative movement element is incorporated to encourage dancers to explore their imagination.

Kinder Ballet: Age 3/4yrs – A creative movement and ballet-based class where dancers have fun exploring movement and music while learning basic ballet positions, movements and skills.

Ballet: Age 5 years and up - Based on technique from the RAD syllabus, dancers are taught classical elements along with character and free movement work. Focus is on building strength, flexibility, and alignment through ballet technique. Dancers will participate in both bar and floor work.

Acro: Age 5 years and up - Based on technique from the BATD, DMA, PAEC and CDTA syllabi, dancers are working on controlled movements which combine gymnastics and jazz. Dancers will practice strength and stability through conditioning, walkovers, balances and more.

Hip Hop: Age 5 years and up - Based on street style dance and choreographed to contemporary music using styles like hip hop, funk and free-style. This type of dancing is seen in music videos.

Jazz: Age 5 years and up - Based on jazz technique from the BATD, DMA, PAEC and CDTA syllabi, dancers are working to achieve various jumps, turns as well as increase their flexibility.

Tap: Age 5 years and up - Based on tap technique from the BATD, DMA, PAEC and CDTA syllabi, dancers are working progressively with different rhythmical elements, in conjunction with different steps to build a vocabulary of movement

Theatre Jazz: Age 5 years and up - Based on the portrayal of a character through lip syncing, this form of dance incorporates elements of jazz technique along with drama

Contemporary: Age 10 years and up - Based on a combination of techniques including Jazz, Ballet and Modern. Dancers are working to portray a character or tell a story through their movement and expression.

Dance Attire: *No jewelry, no jeans or non stretch attire, and competitive performance shoes and tights will be posted later.*

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent & Tot: Age @2 years- Any style dancewear and or shorts & t-shirts will be permitted. Hair pulled back off the face in a ponytail. Bare legs and bare feet are appropriate for this class.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kinder Ballet: Age 3/ 4 years - Any style dancewear will be permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be ponytail or bun. Pink Ballet Shoes are required.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kinder Gym: Age 3/4 years - Any style dancewear will be permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be ponytail or bun. Bare feet are required.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kinder Bop: Age 3/4 years - Any style athletic wear is permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be in a ponytail. Bare feet are required.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ballet: Age 5/6 years - Lilac Mondor Bodysuit #1635 bodysuit, with pink ballet tights (Mondor style #345, #310, #314, #316, #319) or pink ankle socks Mondor #167. Hair must be in a proper bun, with hair net and bobby pins. Pink Ballet shoes are to be worn. Wrap over skirt - colour to match leotard; Mondor style #16100.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ballet: Age 7years and up - Purple Mondor #3546 bodysuit with pink tight pink. Hair must be in a proper bun, with hair net and bobby pins. Pink soft ballet shoes in satin, canvas, or leather, with pink elastic.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ballet Boys & Graded RAD Ballet Boys- A solid white T- shirt, black bike pants or leggings, black or white ballet shoes with black or white socks.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graded RAD Ballet Girls: Pre-Primary & Primary - Lilac Mondor Bodysuit #1635 bodysuit, with pink ballet tights (Mondor style #345, #310, #314, #316, #319) or pink ankle socks Mondor #167. Hair must be in a proper bun, with hair net and bobby pins. Pink Ballet shoes are to be worn. Wrap over skirt - colour to match leotard; Mondor style #16100.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graded RAD Ballet Girls: Grades 1 to 5 - Purple Mondor #3546 bodysuit with pink tight pink (Mondor style #345, #310, #314, #316, #319). Hair must be in a proper bun, with hair net and bobby pins. Pink soft ballet shoes in satin, canvas, or leather, with pink elastic. Character skirts and Character shoes will be required for graded Ballet classes only.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vocational Ballet Girls - Any style Sleeveless leotard - black, Waistband (optional) - 2 cm elastic, the same colour as leotard, Tights: pink (Mondor style #345, #310, #314, #316, #319), Soft pointe shoes or soft ballet shoes - pink with ribbons. Pointe shoes (pointe work section) - pink with ribbons
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acro: Age 5 years and up- Any style dancewear will be permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be ponytail or bun. Bare feet are required.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hip Hop: Age 5 years and up- Any style athletic wear is permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be in a ponytail. Dancers are to wear, clean running shoes. <i>Black running shoes for all recreational Hip Hop recital dances.</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tap: Age 5 years and up- Any style dancewear will be permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be ponytail or bun. Tap Shoes are required. <i>Black Tap Shoes for all recreational tap recital dances.</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jazz: Any style dancewear will be permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be in a ponytail or bun. Shoes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Age 5 to 6 years – bare feet. - Age 7years and up - a jazz shoe. <i>Black jazz shoes for all recreational jazz recital dances 7 +</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Theater Jazz: Age 5 years and up - Any style dancewear will be permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be in a ponytail or bun. Jazz shoes are required. <i>Black jazz shoes for all recreational MT recital dances</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contemporary: Age 10 years and up - any style dancewear will be permitted but must be suitable for dancing. Hair is to be in a ponytail or bun. - bare feet
