Contact TDS Directly

Unless it is an emergency, please do not use personal contact information or social media to contact any of the staff about anything studio related. All communication should be done through TDS by emailing or calling the studio directly. dance@thedanceshoppe.com, 905-878-1488.

USB Sticks

Competitive Dancers wishing to have a copy of their competitive music are asked to please drop off a labelled USB stick at the front desk. Make sure it is clearly labeled with the dancers' name and company. We only need one USB per family.

Electronic Devices - Changerooms/Bathrooms.

Please remind your dancer(s) that they are NOT to use their electronic devices, (cameras, video, facetime etc) in the changerroom or bathroom areas. This is for privacy and safety of all our dancers.

Attendance/Vacations

Just a friendly reminder that you have committed to a Competitive Dance Team for 10 months. Your dancer(s) attendance is mandatory during this commitment. Taking an extended family vacation during the season is not fair to your teammates but also puts a lot of pressure on your dancer(s) to keep up with the team. TDS will not condone or permit any "vacations" that take dancers out of the studio for multiple weeks. Families who insist on being away may forfeit their dancers' spot on the team.

Highschool Exams-IMPORTANT

Just a reminder that all highschoolers will have exams. It is imperative that you let us know your dancers' exams schedule and if they need a night off to study. Nothing is worse than one dancer calling in last minute and someone else that had planned their time wisely or rushed to study so they can attend their evening classes, only to attend and half the class is there. If multiple dancers need the same night off, and if we know in advance, we can re-schedule the classes and then everyone can have the night to prepare. TDS can possibly schedule other classes that need extra time or technique classes in their spots and make the night productive for everyone.

Group Routines Come First

If your dancer is sick or will be missing the night of group classes for some reason, please remember that they will also need to miss any extra work for that same day. It is not proper etiquette to show up for your extra work but then not show up for mandatory classes and group choreography. **Groups come first.** It is better to forfeit extra work and try to get through your group and mandatory classes. It is a lot easier to make up a solo, duet, or trio than it is to get a group of 12 dancers together to make up the time missed.

RAD Late Spring Exams

1) The RAD offers both Class Award Presentations and Exams.

Award/Presentation Class is an opportunity for dancers to perform the RAD syllabus work for an examiner in a less stressful environment. Dancers are not marked on their work and cannot fail.

Exams are not suitable for every pupil. They are expected to practice at home and come to any extra coaching sessions leading up to the exam. Obviously, this is not always attainable due to absence, illness, or even shyness on the part of the pupil.

2) Students could be offered one or the other, or neither.

3) This is not a reflection of your dancers' potential, and is based on a variety of factors including, but not limited to:

- Their ability to retain all of the exercises and perform them without guidance.
- The development of their technique.
- Their focus within the classroom and ability to follow direction clearly.
- Their ability to handle more stressful situations.

4) Not being offered the opportunity to perform your Class Award Presentation or Exam does not mean that you will not move forward to the next RAD Level next season. As long as your dancer continues to work hard and we have not informed you of any concerns, they will continue on to the next syllabus.

Free Studio Space for Extra Work Choreography.

As always TDS is happy to provide free studio space to all our dancers to practice their extra work routines throughout the week. There are half hour time slots available, maximum of two solo/duet/trios in the room at once OR one group. If you are the last one in the studio, please make sure to return the iPod to the front desk and turn the power and lights off in the studio. Please note that free studio space availability may change, sometimes last minute, if TDS requires the space.

Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather, please call the studio or check the website to see if we are cancelling studio classes for that day. If we feel the need to cancel studio classes, we will leave a message on the studio phone, send an email, and try to post on our website, social media, and our App. If you are unsure about coming, please call us at 905-878-1488 before travelling to the studio. We will be thinking Safety First!

Competitive Shoe and Tight List 2025

TDS has already provided the competitive shoe and tight list for all 2024/2025 competitive groups. We will also provide a shoe and tight list for all duets/trios and solos that TDS is responsible for designing in the next few weeks. If dancers are wanting to not wear tights for their solos/duets/trios they may do so, they just need to be approved by TDS.

TDS Competitive Stage Look- Reminders

For the safety of the dancers, we ask that all dancers remove any **extra jewellery**, example earrings, nose, lip, eyebrow rings and if 2-piece costume bellybutton rings. (Anything visible to the audience.) Fake nails may be worn if they are a French or clear finish and are not overly long or pointy.

TDS Competitive Make Up Kits

The benefits of “stage” make up as opposed to off the shelf makeup are that it gives us a unified team look, stays on longer and shows up brighter. It gives your dancer the professional stage looks without having to re-apply. Competitive stage makeup is a good investment that finishes our competitive look. Dancers are judged on their appearance, this includes make up, hair, and costumes. Good make up does not wash out the dancer’s expression and highlights their face, which is also important on the stage. It is imperative that we put our best foot forward and complete the look.

Reminder: Full Time Dancers, Small Fry and up will be wearing fake lashes again this season.

We will run full group rehearsals on the Saturday March 1st and Sunday March 2nd and a Showcase of competitive groups on the Sunday late afternoon/early evening. ***Please note that due to the number of routines, Extra Work Groups will not perform in this year's showcase.*** Schedule coming soon...

Hotels for Competitions

Please note that TDS is not responsible for booking rooms for our competitive events. Each family's schedule is different, and you may or may not want to book rooms. It is not mandatory that anyone stay overnight. You can visit each competitions website for hotel information. Remember – once schedules are released by the events, rooms can be cancelled or on the other side, may be come available.

Group Fundraisers
